DROP- IN PLAY RULES

- At “drop-in play” times, all courts (with the exception of teaching and challenge courts) are designated for drop in play.
- Courts are split into 2 levels, “A” & “B” (*“A” courts being stronger in level than “B” courts*)
- Courts 5-8 are designated as “A” courts and courts 1-4 are designated as “B” courts.
- Players will self-rating.
- Players rotate in from the cue at court 6 for “A” court matches and court 3 for “B” court matches.
- When a drop in match is over the entire group will rotate off the court and players who are waiting will rotate in. In the event less than 4 players are waiting, the players coming off the court will take turns rotating off. All players rotate equally.
- During this time appointed monitors will be playing to keep it organized, rotating, and moving.
